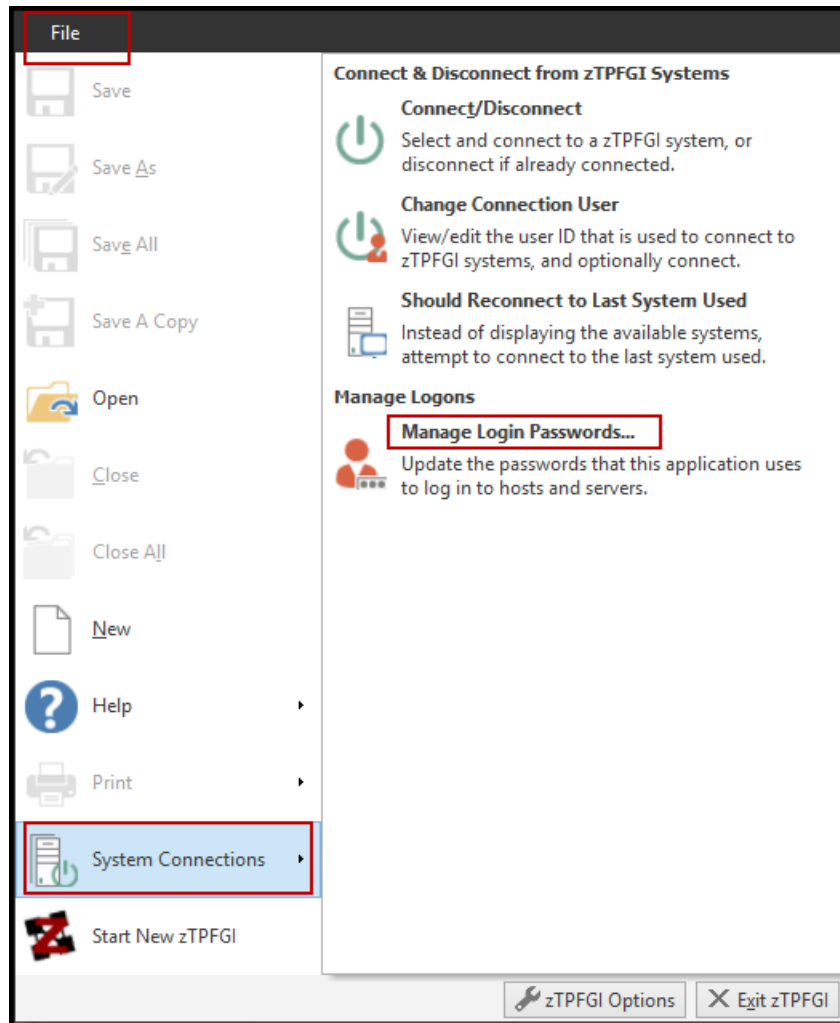

Introduction

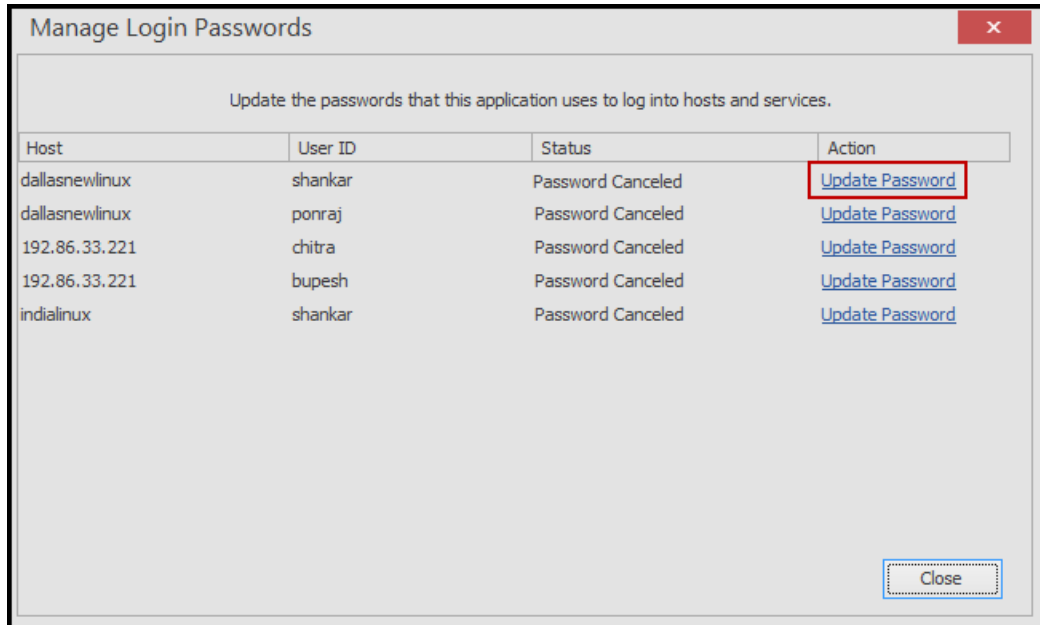
The Update Password feature allows you to update the VM and Linux Servers passwords in zTPFGI which were set in their respective terminals.

How do I update password in zTPFGI?

1. Launch zTPFGI, open the **File** tab, then click **System Connections** and **Manage Login Passwords...**

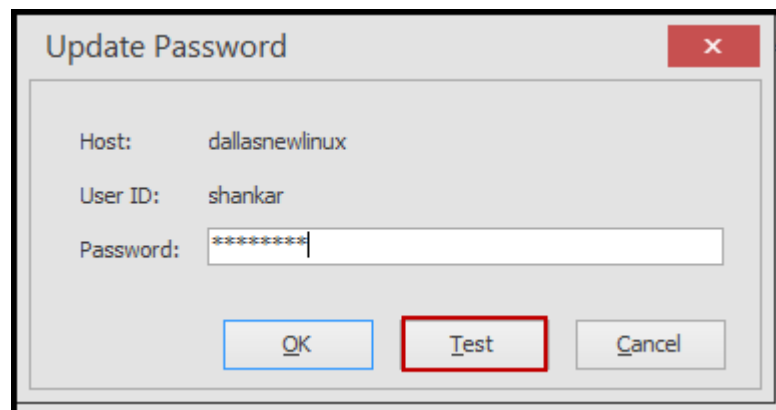


The Manage Login Passwords pop-up window displays



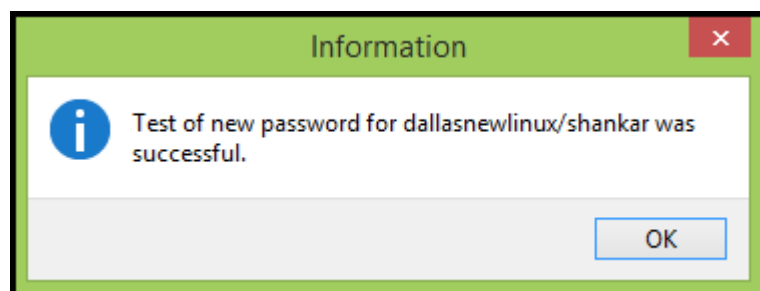
- In the **Manage Login Passwords** pop-up window, select the **Update Password** link corresponding to system for which you want to update the password.

*The **Update Password** pop-up window displays*



- Enter the password that you have set in the terminals in the **Password** text box.
- Click the **Test** button to validate and save the entered password <OR> Click the **OK** button to update the password.

*The **Information** pop-up window displays the validation (successful or failed) status of the entered password.*
